**NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM [NSP] 2**  
**DEKALB COUNTY, GEORGIA**  
**PUBLICATION DATE: JULY 2, 2009**

DeKalb County is proposing to be a part of a regional application, Atlanta Region NSP2 Consortium, to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development [HUD] requesting, Neighborhood Stabilization 2 Program funds. The NSP 2 Program is a national competition for funding to address the problems in neighborhoods caused by housing foreclosures. The application will be completed and submitted to HUD by July 17, 2009, 5:00 P.M. EST. The participating organizations in the Atlanta Region NSP2 Consortium application are the Atlanta Regional Commission, Atlanta Neighborhood Development Partnership, Inc. [ANDP], Clayton County, DeKalb County, Douglas County, Gwinnett County, Henry County, and Rockdale County.

The NSP 2 funds were provided through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 [ARRA], frequently known as the "Stimulus" bill. The NSP 2 funds will be requested by the Atlanta Region NSP Consortium to help stabilize neighborhoods through the acquisition/rehabilitation subsequent resale, lease-purchase, or rental of foreclosed and vacant residential properties, as determined appropriate by each participating organization. Each participating community will be responsible for the implementation of the NSP 2 Program within its jurisdiction.

The total Atlanta Region NSP Consortium request for funds is likely to be between \$40 Million and \$60 Million. The amount of funding which each participating organization in the NSP Consortium would receive from HUD NSP 2 has not yet been finalized, as HUD will determine the final amounts awarded to any applicant organization sometime around the end of 2009.
